Points of Departure provides nine units which develop learning activities around the writings: Our Stories Ourselves; Taking Risks; In My Mind's Eye; Stepping Out of the Box; Stories That Make us Laugh; Parents and Grandparents; Finding Our Way; Sharing Our Knowledge. They share a format of reading, sharing and writing. They also suggest other themes that could be addressed using the writings as a starting point including: not reading and learning to read; cultural pride; losing and regaining culture; voice; racism; alcohol, addictions, suicide; traditional ways; anger; poetry.
