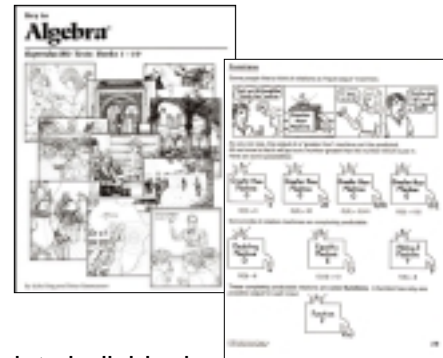


MATH BOOKS

EMPower is a new curriculum written for and piloted with adult learners. This is a breakthrough series which is already proving very effective, especially for group learning.



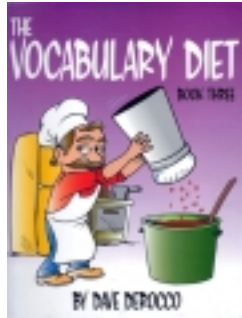

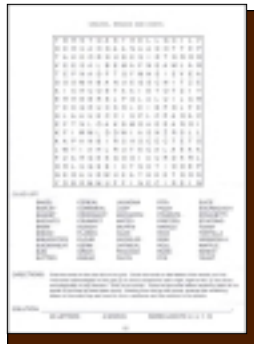
WRITTEN & SPOKEN ENGLISH
