Some of the books in this list are in Somali only: others are dual-text books in English and Somali. They are all published in paperback only unless otherwise stated. The items are organized into the following sections:

Language books, including dictionaries, phrase books, and language teaching books.

Poetry, Songs, Proverbs, Folk Tales and other aspects of the Somali oral tradition.

Books suitable for adult education and family literacy, mostly in dual-text editions.

Children's books, which are in two groups: the first includes Somali children's stories and books written for children in Somali; the second are popular children's books written in English which have been produced in dual-text English-Somali editions.

Books about Somalia, in English are listed in *Peppercorn Catalog 5: Books on Somalia*.

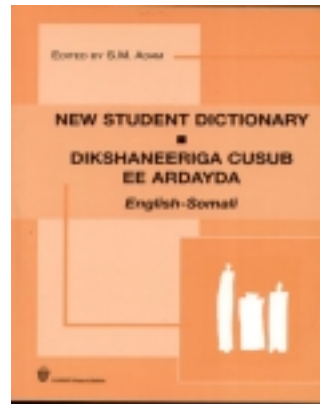
